



ACCIDENT INVESTIGATION WORKSHOP



INTRODUCTION

This workshop will explain why accidents occur, the events that lead to them and how these can be recognised, as well as how to take pro-active steps to prevent accidents thus reducing civil claims.

It also covers the possibility of criminal charges and uninsured losses and how to determine the basic causes of accidents and how to investigate thoroughly. And includes how to ask the questions that provide useful answers and to compare these answers with those obtained from other sources.
