INTRODUCTION

Automated External Defibrillation (AED) is no longer just for doctors and paramedics. Advances in technology now make it possible for rescuers with very limited training to save lives by providing defibrillation following sudden cardiac arrest.

Over 270,000 people in the UK suffer from a heart attack every year. Clinical studies have shown that victims of Sudden Cardiac Arrest who are defibrillated immediately have over 90% chance of survival.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

All staff and currently certificated first aiders. Participants are advised to dress appropriately as they will be required to work on the floor for practical sessions. This course can be run in-house or individuals can attend our open courses.
