- Framework of safety legislation linked to the management of construction, engineering and building projects.
- The revised CDM regulations 2007 and the new ACoP.
- The elements of the revoked Construction (Health & Safety & Welfare) Regs 1996.
- Contents of the Health & Safety pack, construction phase Health & Safety plan and Health & Safety file.
- Basic functions of the safety plans and the safety file.
- Risk Assessment and safety method statements specifically related to delegate needs e.g. Designer, Principal Contractor and Contractors.
- Gaining a sound working knowledge of regulations and how these should be interpreted and put into effect.
- Ensuring adequate communication.
- Planning and overall management of the project.

Delegates are encouraged to bring to the course matters that are of concern to them in the implementation of their projects.
